As alcohol service is often a component, careful planning and training of volunteers and staff is needed to ensure that special events are enjoyable, profitable and safe. This training provides tools and information to help reduce liability while promoting safety and compliance with applicable local and state laws.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** Servers, bartenders, event planners, and others volunteering or working at events where alcohol is sold or served.

**TRAINING TOPICS:** Napa Police Department Conditions of Operation; California alcohol laws; criminal and civil liability; acceptable IDs; checking IDs; refusing service; and much more!

**CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION:** Training attendees will receive a certificate of completion valid for two years. This training meets the Napa Police Department requirements for conditions of operations.
